

Dr Thyssen is a clinical dermatologist and Professor employed by the Capital Region and University of Copenhagen in Denmark.

He is a member of several societies and working groups including the International Eczema Council, the European Task Force of Atopic Dermatitis, European Society of Contact Dermatitis, and European Dermato-Epidemiology Network. His primary scientific and clinical focus is eczema/dermatitis (both atopic and contact), filaggrin, psoriasis, and rosacea.

He has published more than 375 articles, 14 book chapters, and has been editor of 3 Springer textbooks. He is a section editor of Contact Dermatitis and an associate editor of Dermatitis and British Journal of dermatology. His research is based on epidemiological as well as experimental studies.

In particular, Dr Thyssen uses general population cohorts and nationwide registries to study comorbidity and prognosis of inflammatory skin disease. Additionally, he performs experimental studies of the skin barrier function in health and disease.
