

**SkaidraValiukeviciene**, MD is the Head of Skin and Venereal Diseases Department of Medical Academy of Lithuanian University of Health Sciences (LUHS) since 2002, correspondingly the Professor – since 2008. In 2002 she finished PhD studies at Kaunas University of Medicine with doctoral thesis 'Prevalence of Pigmented Nevi of Children and Relation Between Constitutional, Phenotypic Factors and Sun Exposure'. In 2008 she passed Habilitation Procedure at Kaunas University of Medicine ('Diagnostics and Prevention of Melanocytic Skin Tumors and Sexually Transmitted Infections: Results of Epidemiological and Clinical Studies'). Professor Skaidra Valiukeviciene is a member of these associations: Lithuanian Society of Dermatovenereology, German Society of Dermatology (Corresponding member), Association of Dermato-oncology (ADO), European Academy of Dermatology and Venereology, Baltic Association of Dermatovenereologists (Honorary member). Professor works as a consultant for Dermatovenereology at the Ministry of Health of Lithuania. She is the **leading manager of two EU projects** such as EurostarsSkinMonitorNo E!4846'Diagnosis of Skin Cancer Based on Information and Communication Technologies Tools' (2009-2012) and Framework 7 project SkinDetectorNo 314913 'Application of the innovative data fusion based on non-invasive approach for management of the diabetes mellitus: [www.skindetector.eu](http://www.skindetector.eu)'(2009-2014). Since 2004 she has been the principal investigator of 7 clinical studies (Acne, Contact Allergy, Psoriasis, Sexual Transmitted Diseases, Photodynamic Therapy) and 5 clinical trials on Ichthyosis and Atopic Dermatitis in children, Psoriasis and Biologics. Skaidra Valiukeviciene is supervisor of 3 full finished doctoral PhD studies. During 2009-2014 she published 6 books, 20 articles in scientific journals (12 articles with IF) and 60 abstracts. She is on the editorial board of following international journals: Latin American Psoriasis and Psoriatic Arthritis Journal (since 2010), Dermatology and Therapy, US (since 2011) and Aktuelle Dermatologie, Germany (since 2013).
