Dr. Brett King received his B.A. at the University of California at Santa Cruz, his Ph.D. from Stanford University and his M.D. from Yale University School of Medicine. He completed medical internship at Massachusetts General Hospital and dermatology residency at Yale University School of Medicine.

Dr. Brett King is Associate Professor of Dermatology, specializes in inflammatory skin diseases – in particular alopecia areata, vitiligo and atopic dermatitis – as well as hair loss disorders. He pioneered the use of Janus kinase (JAK) inhibitors in dermatology, and his work has revealed the broad utility of JAK inhibitors for the treatment of alopecia areata, vitiligo, atopic dermatitis, granulomatous diseases, as well as other conditions.

Dr. King is an investigator in numerous clinical trials. He lectures nationally and internationally and publishes extensively.
