

I received my board certifications in Dermatology in 2005. During my training as dermatologists, I was always interested in psoriasis at a time when biological treatments were not yet available in Colombia. My thesis was related to the behavior of psoriasis in my hospital and the impact generated by this research was such that received the national award for research in the XXVII and XXVIII National Congress of dermatology and dermatologic surgery respectively.

In 2010, in the company of dermatologists and rheumatologists interested in psoriasis, we decided to found Colombian Psoriasis Group (CoLPsor) and began publishing our experience, which allowed me to become editor of Evidence-based Guidelines for the Management of Psoriasis in Colombia for 2010- 2012-2018 and in the current version 2021, actually in process.

Since 2012 I have been a member of the International Psoriasis Council (IPC) which has a big responsibility but at the same time, has allowed me to share my work as speaker at numerous international conferences in dermatology, rheumatology aesthetic medicine and internal medicine.
