Current Position

Professor and Chairman, Department of Dermatology at Paul Sabatier University, Toulouse, France since 2006. The department is the Dermatology reference center for the 3 Mio population of the Midi-Pyrenees region and includes inpatient, day-care center and outpatient clinics, a clinical research center (phase I to IV) and teaching facilities. Since 2014, a dermatology oncology unit has been open in the Comprehensive Oncology Hospital and includes a Dermatology unit affiliated to the University department. The department comprises a team of about 32 physicians including 12 full time Dermatologists, 10 residents and 10 part-time dermatologists.
